The report explores the transformations taking place in national vocational training and education systems in Latin America and the Caribbean. It particularly focuses on the change in the key objective of skills training, which has shifted from mastering specific tasks to developing transferable competencies. The report finds that the rapid development of information and communications technologies has transformed teaching and learning methods, as the limits of space, time and content that once characterized training can be easily overcome now. The greater diversity of demand, linked to a more diversified production structure and more diverse training requirements, has resulted in a wider variety of available training programmes but has also generated new challenges in coordination and quality control of education and training.
